Why is faith in Jesus Christ the only means of salvation and why is His blood the only blood that could atone for man's sin once and for all?

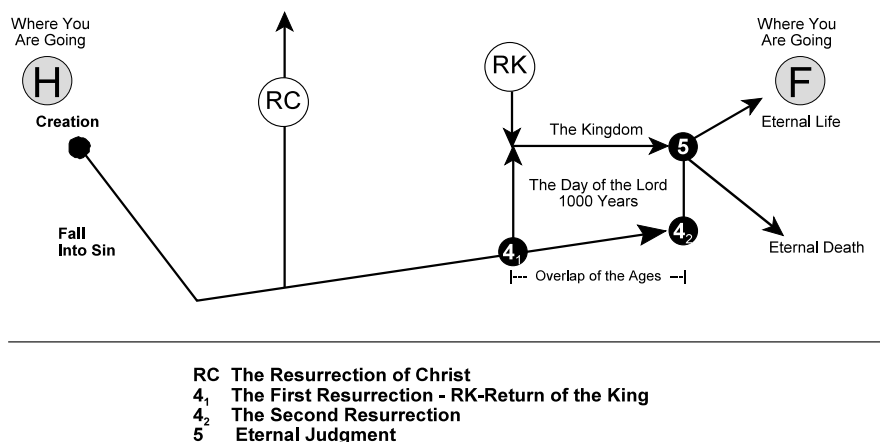
Read Acts 1:1-8 and answer the two questions below.
