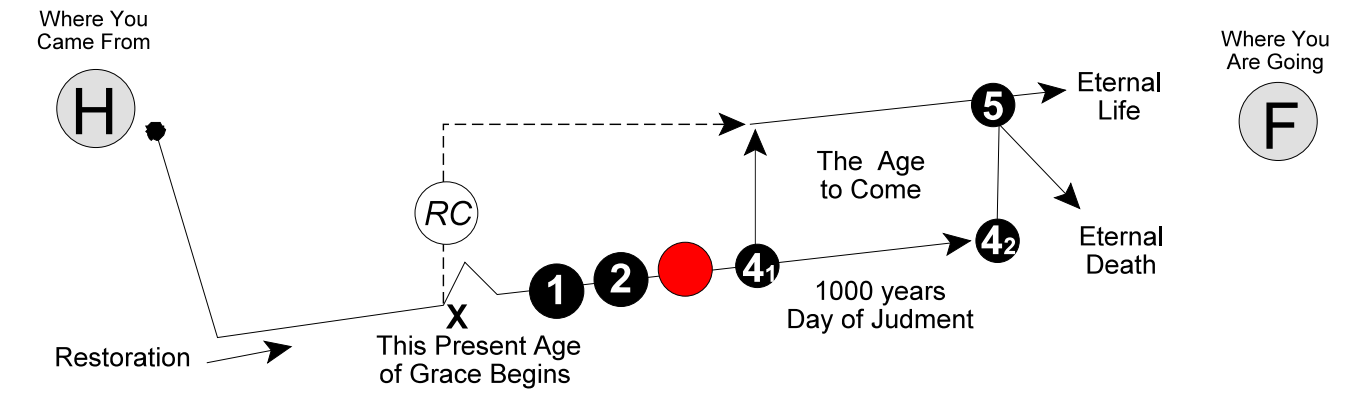
More Waves of Revival
